RE: Medicaid Managed Care Common Formulary

Dear UOP Provider:

UOP aims to ensure our providers are updated with the latest information that might be of special interest to them. The Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) has recently created a common formulary to ease access for members and providers looking for information on drugs covered by Michigan Medicaid managed care plans. In order to simplify drug coverage policies for Medicaid and Healthy Michigan Plan members and providers, the MDHHS along with the help of the Managed Care Organizations have created a formulary that is common across all contracted Medicaid Health Plans. The purpose of the common formulary is to facilitate collaboration among health plans as well as reduce interruptions in a recipient's drug treatment due to a change in health plan.

Remember, plans may choose to include supplementary drugs that are not on the Managed Care Common Formulary in their own drug formularies. Also, plans may implement drug utilization management policies such as quantity limits, age and gender edits, prior authorization standards that are less limiting than the coverage restrictions of the Managed Care Common Formulary.
